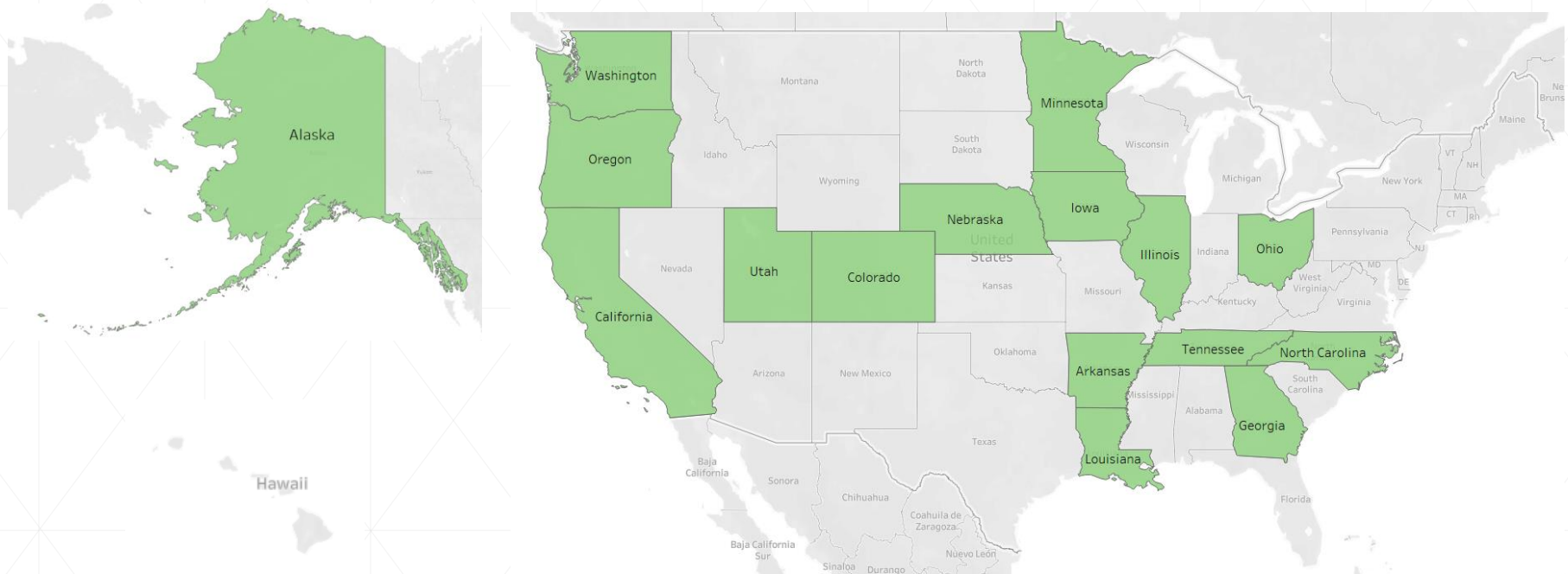

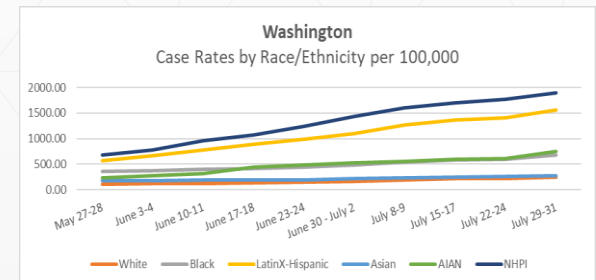
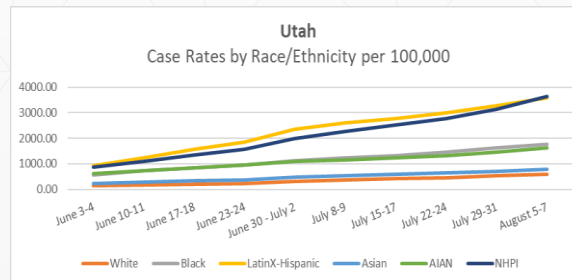
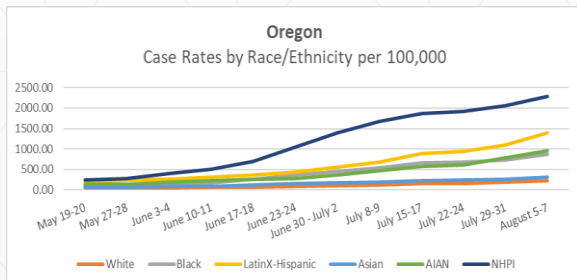
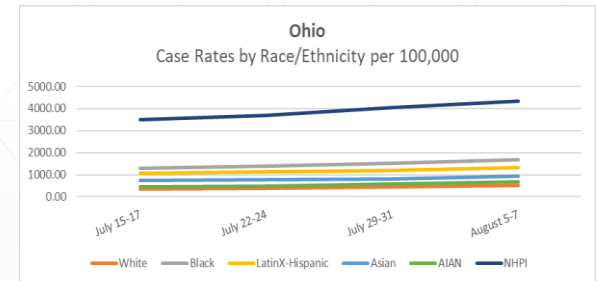
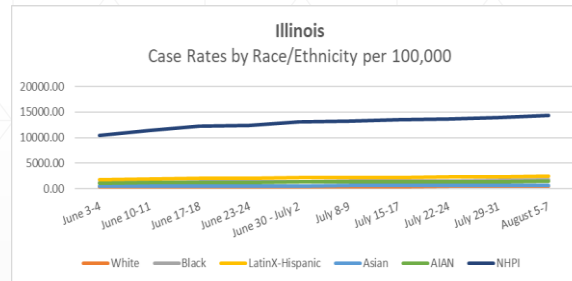
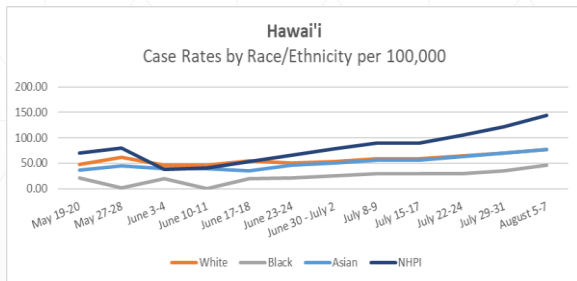
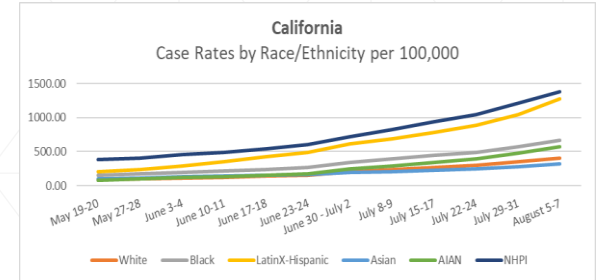
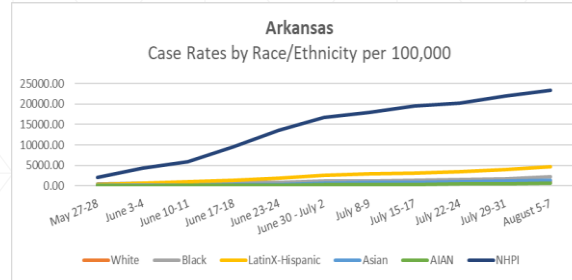
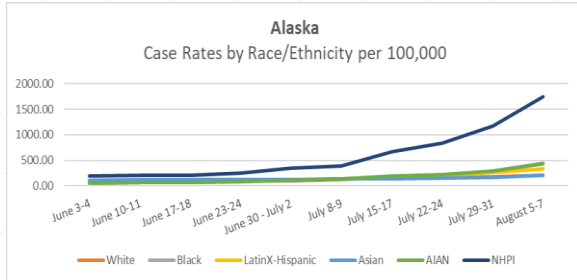


Compliance with OMB Statistical Policy Directive No. 15*: States Reporting Disaggregated Asian American and NHPI COVID-19 Cases and Deaths

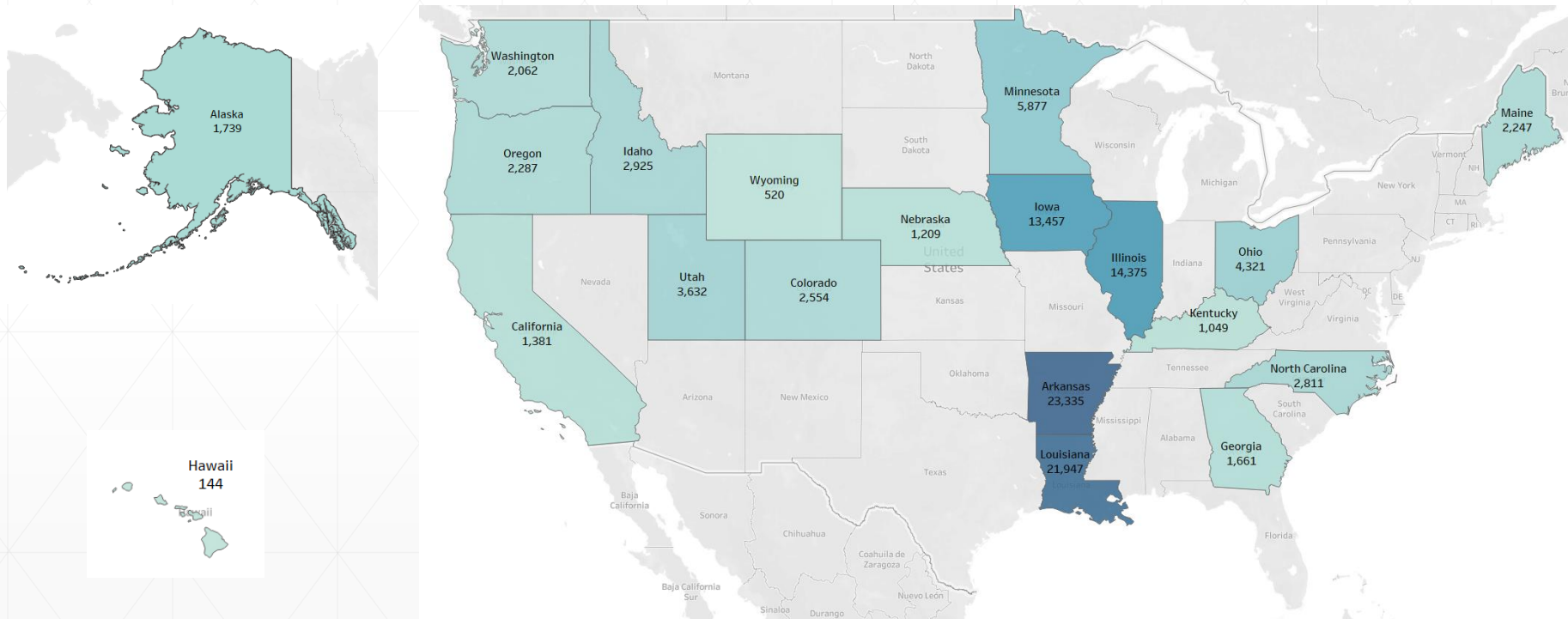

“Rates Per 100k” represents the number of NHPIs that have tested positive for COVID-19 within each state, divided by the NHPI population multiplied by 100,000, in order to make comparisons with other communities.
